Mills conform to HACCP principles

The principles of HACCP (Hazard Analysis Critical Control Point) pertain to food safety – both animal and human. These practices stand vigil over La Coop's production facilities so that, while improbable, any contamination in the mill is immediately detected and corrected.



CRITICAL FACTORS FOR SUCCESS IN EQUINE NUTRITION



KEEP YOUR HORSE HYDRATED

Horses should have access to clean water at all times, including winter time, to both maintain proper levels of hydration and reduce the risk of colic.

WEIGH YOUR HORSE

Nutritional recommendations depend in large part on the weight of your horse. Weight should be checked regularly. The best tool is the scale, but a weigh tape can give a good estimate.

WEIGH THE FEED

Feeds of the same type can have different densities. Make sure you are feeding your horse the proper portion by weighing the food, rather than measuring the volume.

CHECK FORAGE QUALITY

Hay should be free of dust, mold, and weeds. It's the most important part of the horse's diet. To ensure hay quality and determine its composition, a laboratory analysis is strongly recommended.

SERVE MULTIPLE MEALS

Feed should be divided into at least two meals per day. The more concentrated the feed, the more important the number of meals becomes. Dividing the daily ration into several servings reduces the risk of colic, digestive disorders, laminitis, and glycemic overload. A meal should never contain more than 1.5 kg of feed for a 500 kg horse.

EVALUATE BODY CONDITION

Combine training and diet work together to maintain optimal body condition. Review and revise the training program, the quantity of feed served, and the ration's energy balance as needed. To evaluate your horse's body condition, see chart on the next page.

KEEP YOUR HORSE COMFORTABLE

An environment that is quiet, clean, and dry is very important, and that goes for the pasture as well as in the stable. Adequate space, bedding, air quality, safe and secure equipment, and insect control are all important elements to consider.

KEEP AN EYE ON THE PASTURES

Pasture quality is very variable. It is influenced by the forage species present, the climate, seeding, and fertilization. To prevent negative effects during warm periods, access to shade and water are essential.

FULFILL VITAMINS AND MINERAL REQUIREMENTS

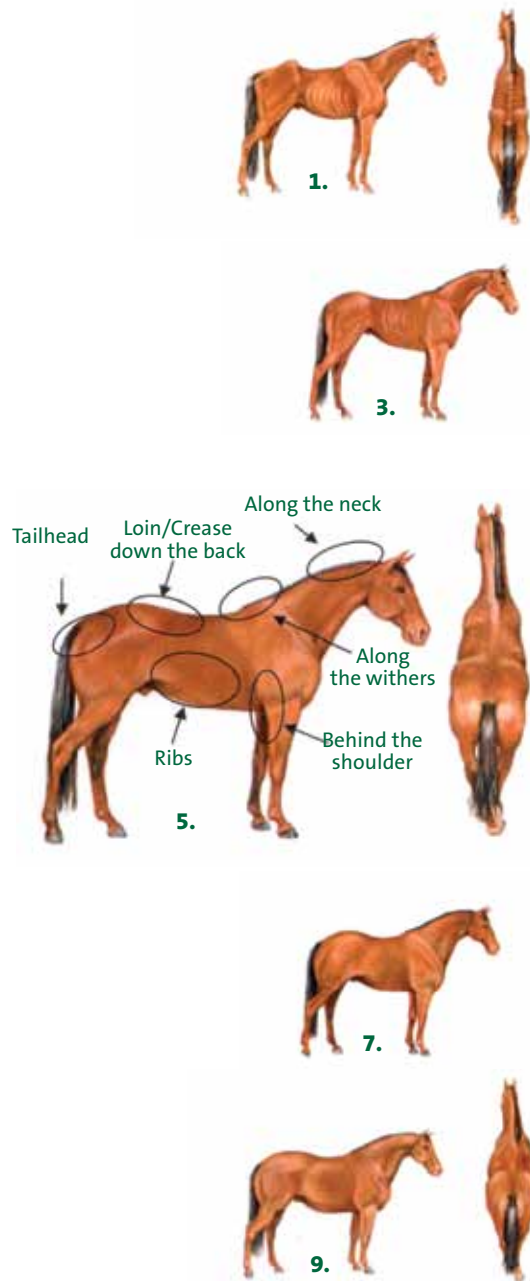
Forages do not contain enough vitamins and minerals to satisfy the needs of your horse. It is therefore essential to provide a supplemental source of these nutrients, via concentrates or vitamin and mineral blocks. Pro-Bloc mineral and good dry hay are great complements to pasture feeding.

ENSURE MEDICAL FOLLOW-UP

Above all, your horse should be in good health. Make sure to follow the preventive medicine plan recommended by your veterinarian.

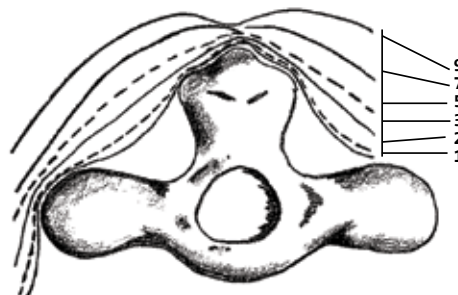

FEED FOR GESTATING OR LACTATING BROODMARES

- Intermediate glycemic index with carbohydrate levels adapted to meet foals' needs



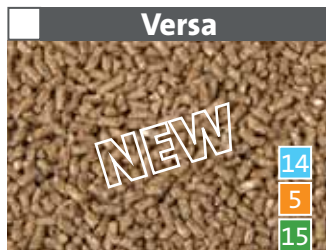
FEED FOR PERFORMANCE HORSES OR WITH HIGH CALORIC REQUIREMENTS

VERY LOW GLYCEMIC INDEX FEED, FOR HORSES WITH MODERATE ENERGY NEEDS

- Without added starch
- Energy from digestible fibre and fats
- Fat content from flax seed, source of Omega-3 fatty acids



FEED FOR MODERATE TO INTENSE EXERCISE AND GROWTH

- Contains yeast, which contributes to digestive tract health and fibre digestion
- Well-balanced in fibre, fat and starch
- Moderate glycemic index



FEED FOR HORSES WHO NEED A GOOD SOURCE OF ENERGY, WITHOUT MOLASSES

- Tasty textured feed with a high proportion of high-quality oats
- Added soybean oil for body condition maintenance



MAINTENANCE FEED OR LIGHT EXERCISE

- Good base feed when paired with high-quality hay or pasture

- Completes low-protein grass hays

PROTEIN SUPPLEMENT WITH VITAMINS AND MINERALS

- For horses with greater needs in protein (broodmares, foals, and active horses)
- Can be used to complete hay low in protein, or poor quality hay
- Contains 24% highly-digestible protein



VITAMIN AND MINERAL SUPPLEMENT FOR HORSES CONSUMING LITTLE OR NO COMPLETE FEED

- With added amino acids essential for protein synthesis
- With added Vitamin B complex, for proper metabolism of carbs, fats and proteins
- Promotes muscle activity and post-exercise recovery
- Low glycemic index



PELLETED VITAMIN AND MINERAL SUPPLEMENT

- Enriched with essential minerals and vitamins, for good metabolic function and maintenance of muscle tissue, bone, hooves, and respiratory, digestive and reproductive systems
- Can complete ration for horses receiving a limited amount of feed



POWDERED CONCENTRATED VITAMIN AND MINERAL SUPPLEMENT

- Contains high levels of calcium, phosphorus and salt, necessary to meet horse's daily requirements
- Generously fortified with minor elements and vitamins for good metabolic function



FREE-CHOICE VITAMIN AND MINERAL SUPPLEMENT

- Source of vitamins and minerals for completing forage- or grain-based rations, or horses who need an additional supplement
- Very appetizing and promotes water consumption

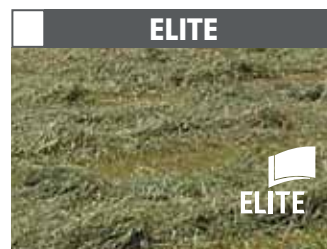
